We were back in business again and looking forward to a bigger and better market.

As president of the historical society, I would urge all of you to support the market. Many of us have already invested a good deal of time and effort in getting it organized. Now we need you folks to step up to the plate and make it a success. Greenfield Farmers Market Starts Friday, June 26, 2009

Hi Folks:

The Farmers Market is on. All of our insurance problems have been solved thanks to the hard work of Ron Feulner and others. We will be sponsored by the Town of Greenfield Historical Society and supported by the Town of Greenfield and the Greenfield Community and Business Association. It is a great partnership between the Town, the Historical Society and the GCBA. We are all working together to make this a success.

We are very excited about this years market. We will be moving to Middle Grove Park (just a hundred yards up the road from where we were at last year). We will have plenty of parking available for everyone – and plenty of space for vendors.

Here is what we will need:

- For those with insurance (commercial vendors) we will need you to list the Town of Greenfield and the Town of Greenfield Historical Society as additionally insured on your policy.
- For smaller vendor that have no insurance – you will simply need to become members of the Historical Society to be covered under our insurance.
- We will be charging a flat \$25 fee – this will cover your membership into the Historical Society and for the advertising in the Moneysaver Newspaper for 10 weeks.
- Those serving food should get a NYS Dept. of Health certificate saying you have a clean kitchen and can serve food.

Also need you to tell me what products you will be selling and will need you to commit to attending at least 7 of the 10 markets we will have this season. Please e-mail me a list of your products and that you will commit to be at 7 markets minimum.

I will hold a planning meeting in the next couple of weeks for vendors that want to come to the market. Please contact me for more information.
